## <u>Instructions for fitting up a welded aluminum frame with channel fillets</u>

- 1. Work in a clean dry area and on a clean soft surface to avoid scratching the acrylic or frame.
- 2. Remove masking from acrylic. Carefully clean both sides using Brillianize and K-drys.
- 3. Place frame face down on a clean smooth surface. Place acrylic in frame.
- 4. Channel fillets are arranged in a box-lap or pinwheel arrangement. Wood inserts should correspond to pre-drilled holes in frame.
- 5. Adjust fillets to hold in acrylic. Screw into place.
- 6. Carefully stand frame up.
- 7. Clean inside of acrylic if needed.
- 8. Place prepared support panel or artwork in frame.
- 9. Place strainer in frame. Cleat should have long edge facing the wall (back of frame).
- 10. Check to see that the fit is not sloppy. Screw through frame into strainer through second set of holes.
